The School of Built Environment and Development Studies seeks to appoint two positions (a Senior Lecturer and a Lecturer) to teach, train, supervise, and provide academic leadership within the Discipline of Planning. The successful candidates will be expected to build a national profile as a professional planning educator, lecture to postgraduate students; contribute to the academic and management functions of the discipline and the School; conduct and publish research, as well as raise the profile of the discipline with the professional community of planners in South Africa and abroad. A minimum requirement for the Senior Lecturer post is both a coursework master degree in Town Planning and a doctorate in Planning and a minimum requirement for the lecturer post is a coursework Masters Degree in Planning. All applicants must have a Masters Degree in Planning and an active registration with SACPLAN. The following are specific requirements for each of the levels:
