The minimum requirement for the lecturer post is a coursework Masters Degree in Planning. All applicants must have a Masters Degree in Planning and an active registration with SACPLAN. - Preferably a PhD but will consider a Masters Degree by coursework in Town Planning;
- Professional registration or eligibility for registration as a professional planner with SACPLAN;
- Teaching, supervision or research experience of at least 3 years at tertiary or research institution (preferably at the postgraduate level);
- Current PhD registration in an accredited university or eligibility of registration for a PhD degree in Planning;
- A research plan that links planning theory and practice to engage undergraduate and postgraduate students; and
