- Evidence of an emerging research and publication record.
- Involvement in community engagement or outreach programmes
- Suitable interpersonal relations and communication skills.
- Proof of registration for a doctorate/ PhD in Sociology would be an advantage

The short-listed candidate may be required to make a presentation on a topic provided by the School.
