The incumbent will oversee the Work Integrated Learning and conduct the related assessment of final year BSc Dietetics and Human Nutrition students for the Community Nutrition Internship in Dietetics (NUT410) Food Service Management Internship in Dietetics (FSMT410) and Therapy Internship in Dietetics (DIET410). Academic duties may have to be fulfilled using blended learning and remote supervision of students.
