Minimum Requirements: Senior Lecturer

- A doctorate in Psychology/ related discipline
- Evidence of a current and sustained publication record in peer reviewed books and journals
- Evidence of successful postgraduate research supervision at the masters and/or PhD levels
- Teaching experience at university level commensurate with relevant UKZN policy
- Registration with the Health Professions Council for at least three years as a Clinical Psychologist or a Counselling Psychologist

Minimum Requirements: Lecturer

- A Masters in Psychology
- Ability to teach in two or more of the following fields: personality theory, psychological assessment, psychotherapy, research methods,

neuropsychology.

- Teaching experience at university level
- Evidence of an emerging research profile as evidenced by publications, conference presentation, or participation in research projects.
- Registration with the Health Professions Council for at least three years as a Clinical Psychologist or a Counselling Psychologist

The short-listed candidate may be required to make a 20 minute presentation on a topic to be provided by the School.
