- At least two of which must be in postgraduate teaching or developing junior staff.
- A record of research commensurate with this level as evidenced by publications in accredited journals and peer reviewed conference proceedings.
- Successful post graduate supervision.
- Professional registration or eligibility for registration

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS: SENIOR LECTURER

- A PhD in Architecture or equivalent.

- A minimum of three years' experience in post graduate teaching in Architecture or equivalent with a proven record of research supervision.
- An emerging record of publications in the field of Architecture or equivalent in approved academic journals, conference papers and peer reviewed publications.
- Professional registration or eligibility for registration
