The Hydrogen Intensity and Real-time Analysis experiment (HIRAX) is a major radio astronomy telescope slated for construction in a radio-quiet area in South Africa. It will detect the effects of dark energy on the distribution of galaxies, traced by their neutral hydrogen emission. Operating between 400 and 800 MHz, HIRAX will also be a world-leading facility for studies of radio transients, pulsars, and hydrogen absorbers.
