Some Key Functions

- Assisting and supervising of students for the duration of each scheduled dissection hall practical session. This includes assistance with queries/questions related to the dissection and the material covered in lectures
- Assisting with the setting up of the DH for practical sessions, spotters and assessments. This includes preparation, review, marking of scripts and timeous setting of questions as requested.
- Assisting with revision (dates outlined on the Academic TT)
- Maintenance of discipline amongst the students while in session. Completing student registers and reporting of all problems to the Academic Coordinator.
- Setting up specimens prior to practicals for the practical session & assisting the academic co-ordinator with marking (when needed)
- Any other function allocated to you by the academic in charge, in the form of student assistance
- Any other functions stipulated by Academic coordinator.
