Southern African Research Consortium for Mental health INTEgration (S-MhINT)

SMhINT is a NIH funded multi-national research and capacity building consortium located in the Centre for Rural Health within the School of Nursing and Public Health at the University of KwaZulu-Natal. Our partners include the University of Washington (UW), Muhimbili University of Health and Allied Sciences (MUHAS) in Tanzania, Health Alliance International (HAI) and the Beira Operations Research Center (CIOB) in Mozambique and the Ministries/Departments of Health in South Africa, Tanzania and Mozambique. S-MhINT aims to use implementation science to strengthen regional mental health integration into primary health, antenatal, and chronic care platforms in under-resourced areas of eastern South Africa, central Mozambique and southern Tanzania. The Translator/Transcriber will be based at the Centre for Rural Health, University of KwaZulu-Natal, and will provide translation and transcription services for qualitative interviews from isiZulu to English.

Minimum Requirements:

- Postgraduate qualification in Social Science or Teaching
- Minimum 6 months proven translation and transcription experience in translating and transcribing qualitative interviews for research in mental health, including focus group discussions from isiZulu to English.
- Fluency in English and isiZulu

- Minimum 6 months experience in public mental health-related research
