The division provides research strategic leadership, promotes research organisational effectiveness and builds strategic partnerships to enhance research. The following postdoctoral fellowship opportunities are available to support the Research Division.

- The research division is working towards strengthening postgraduate education at the University of KwaZulu-Natal, and accordingly, recently-qualified doctoral candidates with training in post-graduate education or experience in post-graduate management are invited to apply for a 2-year fellowship located on the Westville Campus
- Strategic partnerships with internal and external stakeholders are critical to the successful conduct of research and commercialisation of intellectual property. The research division invites recently-qualified post-doctoral scholars in public relations or related fields to apply for a 2-year fellowship located on the Westville Campus
- The research division is also inviting doctoral scholars who recently-qualified in social or health sciences to apply for a 2-year post-doctoral fellowship to join multi-disciplinary teams working on externally-funded strategic research initiatives and in collaboration with international research partners.

Minimum Requirements:

- Completed doctoral degree in the relevant field of study

Eligibility criteria:

- A doctoral degree obtained in the past five years
- Demonstrable experience of working in a higher education institution
- All candidates will be considered, but preference will be given to suitably-qualified South African citizens or permanent residents

Applicants are required to submit the following:

- A cover letter with motivation by the candidate on their suitability for the position available
- A detailed CV including a list of publications and conference presentations
- Names and contact details of two referees familiar with the candidate's experience and skills
- Certified copy of the candidate's doctoral degree certificate
- Certified copy of the candidate's identity document or passport
