- Evidence of excellence as a researcher within the discipline;
- Track record of successful research supervision of Masters and PhD candidates;
- Leadership in Teaching and Learning and/or Research.

Senior Lecturer

- Relevant doctoral degree;
- Minimum of three years teaching experience in the discipline at a higher education institution;
- Evidence of excellence as a researcher within the discipline;
- Successful supervision of Masters and/or PhD students.

Lecturer

- A relevant Master's degree; and
- Experience in teaching within the discipline at a tertiary level.

The successful candidate will be expected to complete a PhD within 5 years of date of assumption of duty.
