Minimum Requirements:

- Registration as a Specialist Family Physicians or, alternatively, as Medical Practitioners with the Health Professions Council of South Africa;

- Experience in undergraduate and clinical teaching and programmes;
- Experience in primary health care and district hospital care, particularly in rural hospital settings;
- Computer literacy AND
- Driver's license.

The sessions will be performed in PHC clinics / CHC's in eThekweni and at Northdale Hospital.
