The School has an active group of academic staff contributing to research and teaching in the fields of biogeography, environmental management, geomorphology, GIS, and remote sensing, and seeks an individual who will help in strengthening its activities in Climatology or Hydrology. The incumbent will be tasked with undergraduate teaching within Physical Geography at all levels using curricula in keeping with modern developments in that field, and will assist in developing discipline-wide postgraduate teaching programmes across the School. S/he must show expertise in teaching the content of existing level two and three Physical Geography courses while being encouraged to develop a course in their own field of specialization of Climatology or Hydrology. Furthermore, an understanding of GIS / Remote Sensing will be considered an advantage. In addition to teaching, s/he will be expected to develop and maintain an active research programme that will involve supervision of postgraduate students and attract external funding. S/he will also be expected to be involved in the School administration, outreach activities and possibly take up a leadership role within the Durban Centre of Howard and Westville Campuses.
