The Classics Programme at the University of KwaZulu-Natal is looking for a highly qualified and committed Classicist to complement the current staff profile of the discipline. The potential candidate is expected to be able to teach a broad range of courses from 1st year up to Honours level in Classical Civilisations and both Latin and Classical Greek, to supervise students at undergraduate and postgraduate level, to share administrative duties and other discipline-related activities and to contribute to the research output of the discipline. In accordance with the bilingual language policy at UKZN, the potential candidate will be expected to acquire a working knowledge of isiZulu. The position will be offered as Lecturer / Senior Lecturer and interested candidates are invited to apply for the level they consider appropriate.

The successful candidate will be expected to make significant contribution in teaching, supervision of postgraduate students, actively engage in research/publication and play an active role in the academic life of the School.
